Health Care

Colorcon is committed to improve healthcare access for the underprivileged. We partner with the Government, where possible, and make efforts to play a supplementary role to the existing health infrastructure.

Secondary Focus: Education

Access to quality education is a necessity for the progress of society. We are committed to improving education for underserved communities and select projects to support this goal.



Key Colorcon Programs

Arogya Express – The program provides quality care to villages and underprivileged communities, in the South of Goa, which do not have access to healthcare. Over twenty villages benefit, through two mobile health and one dental van.

Swasth Bharat – By providing villages with toilets and access to water throughout the year. we are improving communities' sanitation and water supplies. In the last year over 150 bio toilets have been constructed and four villages have a water supply infrastructure ensuring year round supply of clean water.

Education programs – Two programs are in place, benefiting thirty schools; one is a non-formal education program where 235 children in seven centers across Goa are provided education and nutrition support. The other program is on inclusive education for children with learning disabilities.

Health Care Program with Dedicated Healthcare Services (DHS) – Support to improve the medicine supply infrastructure at DHS managed centers by constructing a world class medicine storage, through the provision of IT hardware to help connect all the government pharmacies and the DHS office.
